# Apologetics & World Views

Apologetics is the study of how to give reasons for our Christian hope (1 Peter 3:15) and a defense of the Faith. This course seeks to articulate the rational basis for Christianity. In particular, this course will emphasize how students should go about responding to objections and critiques to the Christian faith.

# Bible Doctrine Survey I

This course is a survey and summary of ten major doctrines of the Bible with an emphasis on the pastor or church leader knowing God more fully, while understanding and practicing sound theology.
